On February 21, 2018, and March 14, 2018, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified you of complaints alleging that you violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act") and the Commission's regulations. The Commission considered the allegations raised in the complaints and there were an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe you may have violated the Act and Commission regulations as alleged. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on March 23, 2021. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
