On July 19, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified you that it found reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a), the foreign national prohibition of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. After conducting an investigation and considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on July 12, 2022, to take no further action against you and closed the file in this matter.
