On July 19, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified the Libertarian Party of Florida and Steven Nekhaila in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") that it found reason to believe that the Committee violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a), the foreign national prohibition of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. After conducting an investigation and considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on July 12, 2022, to take no further action against the Committee and closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days.
