Dear Ms. Workman and Mr. Sierra:

On June 14, 2019, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission (the “Commission”) found reason to believe that Keep El Paso Honest and Lindsey Workman in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(a), (b), and (g), and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.4 and 109.10(d) by failing to file reports of receipts and disbursements and independent expenditures with the Commission. After considering the circumstances of this matter, on August 30, 2022, the Commission was equally divided on whether to take no further action in this matter. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
