Dear Vice President Pence:

On March 8, 2018 and May 15, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint and a supplement to the that complaint alleging that you had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On April 22, 2021, the Commission considered the allegations raised in the complaint but there was an insufficient number of votes to dismiss the allegations that you violated the Act as alleged. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
