On March 7, 2018, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, SMP and Rebecca Lambe, in her official capacity as treasurer (“SMP”), of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of 52 U.S.C. § 30104 of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (“the Act”). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your client at that time, and SMP submitted a response on May 3, 2018.

On September 2, 2021, after considering all the information, the Commission determined to take no action regarding SMP and closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission’s decision will follow.
