I have been retained as counsel for non-parties John Bolton Super PAC and Cabell Hobbs, Treasurer ("Bolton") in MUR #s 7351 and 7357, and as Respondents in MUR # 7382.

That tolling agreement extended the time to respond to respond until August 7, 2018. As you know, the former principals of Bolton are now employed in high-level national security position at the White House, and we are working diligently to collect information regarding the alleged violations of federal election laws.
