On August 1, 2019, you were notified that that the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) found reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121, a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and the Commission’s regulation at 11 C.F.R. § 110.20(i).

This letter is to inform you that after conducting an investigation and further considering these matters, the Commission, on September 30, 2021, closed the file in these matters.
