Dear Mr. Levy:

On March 30, 2018, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified your clients, Remember Mississippi and Tommy Barnett in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

The Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe, and equally divided on whether to find no reason to believe, your clients violated the Act. Accordingly, on June 22, 2021, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
