Dear Mr. Marsh:

On September 1, 2021, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Ahern Ad, LLC, that the Commission found reason to believe that an Unknown Respondent violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c) and 52 U.S.C. § 30120(a), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and 11 C.F.R. § 109.10 and 11 C.F.R. § 110.11, provisions of the Commission's regulations, and that the Commission's ensuing investigation found that Ahern Ad, LLC, was responsible for the advertisements at issue in the matter. A copy of the MUR 7355 Complaint was forwarded to your client at that time along with a copy of the Factual and Legal Analysis for the Unknown Respondent. On October 8, 2021, Ahern Ad, LLC, submitted a response to the Commission's reason to believe findings.

Upon further review of the available information, the Commission, on September 22, 2022, voted to substitute the name of Ahern Ad, LLC in place of "Unknown Respondent" in the Commission's previous findings of violations of 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c), 52 U.S.C. § 30120(a), 11 C.F.R. § 109.10 and 11 C.F.R. § 110.11. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined to take no further action against Ahern Ad, LLC and to close the file.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
