On August 1, 2019, the Thom Tillis Committee and Collin McMichael in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Tillis Committee") was notified through counsel that the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") found reason to believe that the Tillis Committee violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121, a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and the Commission's regulation at 11 C.F.R. § 110.20(i).

This letter is to inform you that after conducting an investigation and further considering these matters, the Commission, on September 30, 2021, closed the file in these matters.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). The Commission is not required to issue a Statement of Reasons in this matter, but if one is issued it will be provided to you.
