



**SECOND CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission's agreement to extend the period of time for pre-probable cause to believe conciliation negotiations in this matter, Respondents, McSally for Congress and Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer and McSally for Senate, Inc. and Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer, hereby consent to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement suit that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7380 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for an additional period of 20 (twenty) days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in these matters.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondents.
