The Federal Election Commission ("Commission") has considered your complaint dated May 24, 2018, and determined to dismiss the allegations that the respondents violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). Accordingly, on March 23, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.
