GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Background

On September 25, 1978, the Task Force on Non-Filers referred the Committee to Elect Eugene Carter and Carolyn Mitchell, (committee for candidate Bob Mitchell) to the Office of the General Counsel for their failure to file a thirty day post-primary report as required by 2 U.S.C. § 434 (a)(A)(ii).

The Commission found reason to believe on July 18, 1978, and reasonable cause to believe on August 4, 1978, that the Committee to Elect Eugene Carter and the Carolyn Mitchell Committee were in violation of 2 U.S.C. & 434 (a)(1)(A)(ii). The Press Office published their names on a list of non-filers on September 5, 1978.

On October 16, 1978, the Task Force referred the Friends of Jay Disharoom to the Office of the General Counsel for its failure to file a thirty day post-runoff report. This matter originally designated MUR 768, was incorporated into this MUR. The Commission found reason to believe on August 9, 1978, and reasonable cause to believe on August 25, 1978 that the respondent

violated 2 U.S.C. §434 (a)(1)(A)(ii). The Press Office published the Disharoon Committee on a list of non-filers on September 25, 1978.

Analysis

The Respondents are required by 2 U.S.C. § 434 (a)(1)(A)(ii) to timely file 30 day post-election reports. The Mississippi House primary was held June 6, 1978. The 30 day post primary report was due on July 5, 1978. The primary run-off election was held on June 27, 1978. The 30 day post primary run-off report was due on July 27, 1978.

In the First District, Eugene Carter was defeated, receiving 12.2% of the vote. In the Fourth District, Bob Mitchell was defeated, receiving 8% of the vote. James Disharoon, also of the Fourth District, received 18.5% of the vote and was selected for a run-off election. In that run-off, Mr. Disharoon lost with 42.2% of the vote.

On October 3, 1978, Mr Carter filed a report for the period ending July 31, 1978, covering all of his campaign activities following the primary. Attempts to have the principal campaign committee of Bob Mitchell file a 30 day post primary report have not been successful. On October 27, 1978, an OGC staff member contacted the treasurer for the Friends of Jay Disharoon Committee, Mr. C. Douglas Iazard, by telephone and informed him of his obligations. Mr. Iazard agreed to file a single report, supplying information on all of his campaign activities since the run-off. The OGC staff member contacted

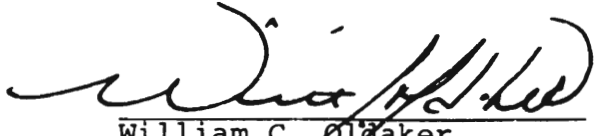
Mr. Disharoon's wife on December 1, 1978 when the committee did not deliver the report. No report has been received to date from the Friends of Jay Disharoon Committee.

As none of the candidates appeared on the general election ballot, and in accordance with Section III D of the Commission's Non-Filer procedures dated May 23, 1978, the Office of the General Counsel recommends that the Commission take no further action at this time against the respondents for their failure to file the required reports.

Recommendation

- 1) Take no further action against the Committee to Elect Carter, Carolyn Mitchell and the Friends of Jay Disharoon.
- 2) Close the file.

The Dantin-Finch contest will be a rematch of sorts. Both were contenders for the Democratic gubernatorial nomination in 1975, with Dantin finishing third in the primary and missing the run-off which was won easily by Finch.

In this year's Republican Senate primary, Cochran ran well nearly everywhere in spite of the support of much of the small Republican hierarchy for Pickering, the former state party chairman. Cochran lost only one of the major counties, Jones, which includes Pickering's home town of Laurel.

In the battle for the Democratic House nomination in Cochran's district, the 4th, Stennis ran ahead of his closest rival by better than 2-1, but fell seven percentage points short of the majority needed to win the nomination.

Disharoon won a spot in the run-off by mounting a costly media drive, financed in large part by family wealth,

which stressed his campaign theme: "Straight Talk, Straight Answers, Straight Government." Disharoon also benefitted from a late endorsement by the state AFL-CIO.

Stennis' campaign focused on his legislative accomplishments, most in the field of financial reform that reflected his influential position as chairman of the state House banking committee. Although enjoying a level of name recognition that far exceeded any of his rivals, Stennis campaigned in a reserved, intellectual manner which left his campaign devoid of much enthusiasm.

In the other districts the House incumbents were all easily renominated, with Democrats Jamie L. Whitten, G.V. (Sonny) Montgomery and David R. Bowen all repulsing primary challengers. Whitten had the most formidable opposition, but still defeated his nearest challenger by better than 2-1.

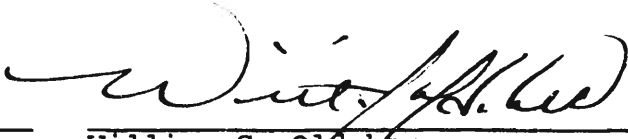
