On June 6, 2018, and on July 26, 2018, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Dr. John Joyce for Congress and Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") of complaints alleging that the Committee had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On March 26, 2019, the Commission considered the complaints but there was an insufficient number of votes to dismiss the allegation that the Committee violated the Act. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision is not required in this matter, but if one is issued, it will be provided to you.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
