On August 4, 2017, your clients, Madison Tenders District Council of Greater New York & LI PAC, were notified that the Federal Election Commission ascertained information in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities indicating that your clients may have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). At that time, your clients were given a copy of the referral from the Reports Analysis Division and informed that a response should be submitted within 15 days of receipt of the notification.

On November 17, 2017, the Commission received additional information from the Reports Analysis Division pertaining to the referral. Enclosed is a copy of this additional information. If you wish to consider this information in your response, you are hereby afforded an additional 15 days to do so, or we will assume any previous response is also intended for this correspondence.
