1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
 - a. Find reason to believe that Indie Party Co. violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104.
 - b. Take no action at this time as to the allegations that Jonathan Jenkins for Senate and Indie Party Co. violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30118(a) and 30125(e)(1).
 - c. Take no action at this time to the allegation that Jonathan Jenkins for Senate violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(h)(1).
 - d. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 22, 2019.
 - e. Authorize the use of compulsory process in this matter, including the issuance of interrogatories, document subpoenas, deposition subpoenas, and orders, as necessary.
 - f. Approve the appropriate letter.
