The mailer was unauthorized by Brian Maryott and his authorized committee, Committee to Elect Maryott US Representative D49, FEC #C00666859. In addition, the mailer does not contain a disclosure containing information about the sponsor or who paid for the political mailing, which violates FEC rules.

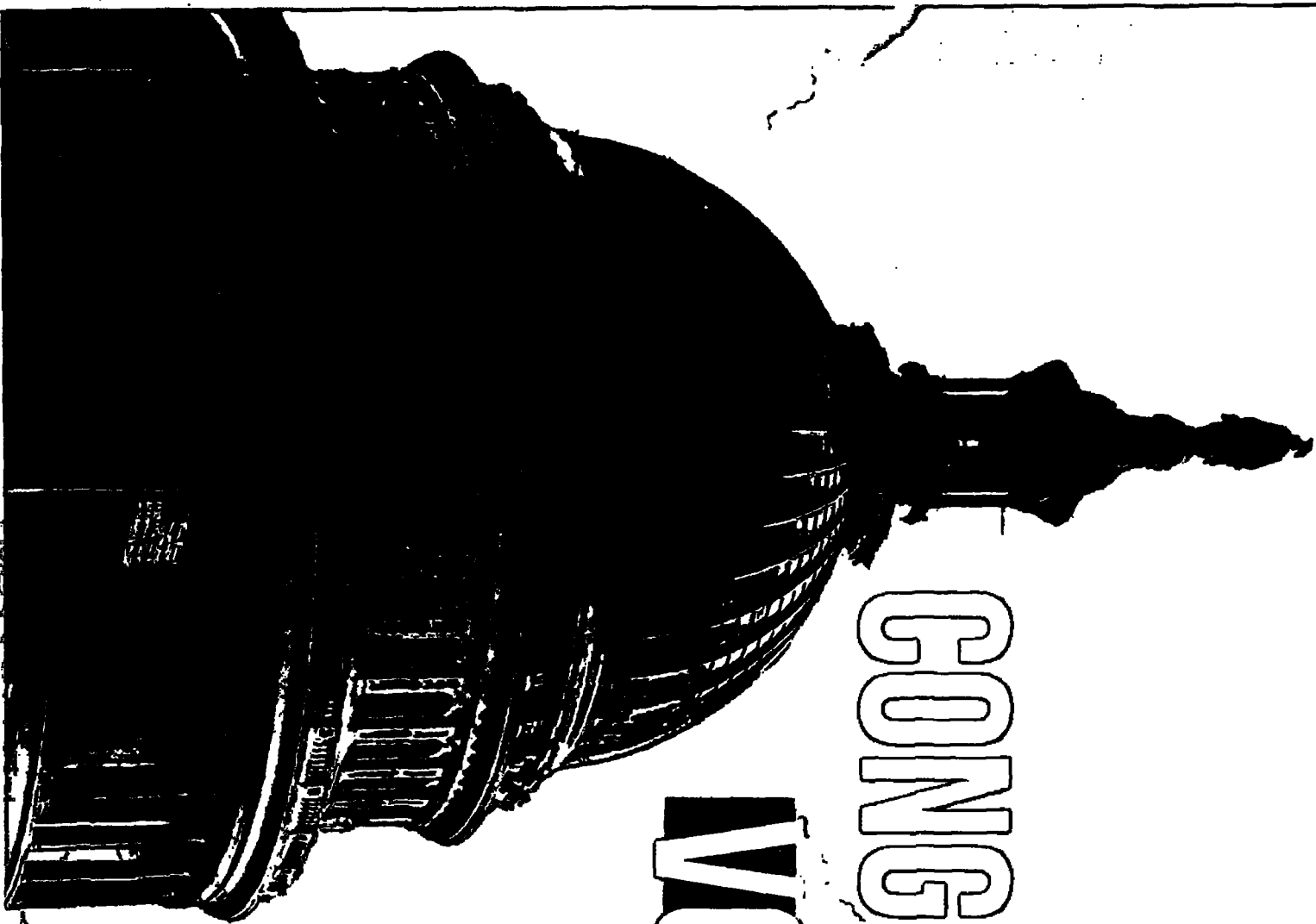

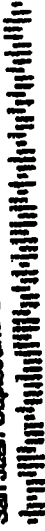

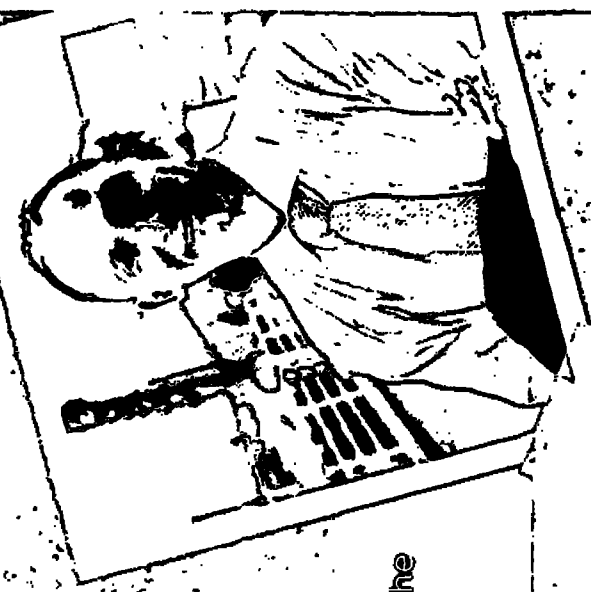
