On July 20, 2018, September 21, 2018, and October 29, 2018, respectively, the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) notified your clients, Cory Gardner for Senate and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer of complaints alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). A copy of each complaint was forwarded to your client at that time.


The Commission considered the complaints but there was an insufficient number of votes to determine whether or not there was reason to believe that your clients violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30104(b), 30116(f), and 30118(a), provisions of the Act. Accordingly, on August 29, 2022, the Commission closed the files in these matters.
