Enclosed please find two executed Statement of Designation of Counsel forms authorizing me to act as counsel in the above-entitled action for Randy Bryce, Randy Bryce for Congress and John Tate, II, in his official capacity as Treasurer of Randy Bryce for Congress.

The complaint in MUR 7437 was received by Randy Bryce for Congress on August 20, 2018. Mr. Bryce did not receive a copy of the complaint until August 25, 2018. As you know, 11 C.F.R. § 111.6(a) provides that a respondent may file a written response to a complaint within fifteen (15) days of receiving it. Since Randy Bryce for Congress received the complaint on August 20, 2018, a response is due a week from today on September 4, 2018.

Although I have initiated an investigation into the allegations of the complaint, there will not be sufficient time complete the effort and file a written response on behalf of all the above-named respondents by September 4, 2018. In order to prepare a complete response, I will need to interview a number of witnesses who may have direct knowledge of the events alleged to have occurred in the complaint. Accordingly, I hereby request an extension of time of thirty (30) days until October 4, 2018 in order to file a response to the complaint in MUR 7437 on behalf of all of the above-named respondents.
