On July 31, 2018, your clients, American First Action, Inc. and Jon Proch in his official capacity as treasurer, were notified that the Federal Election Commission received a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. At that time you were given a copy of the complaint and informed that responses to the complaint should be submitted within 15 days of receipt of the notification.
