Dear Mr. Jordan,

On August 22, 2018, your office granted my request for a 30-day extension – until September 21 – for Twitter, Inc. to respond to the complaint filed in MUR 7443. On August 23, 2018, your office also granted my request for a 30-day extension – until September 28 – for Twitter, Inc. to respond to a factually and legally similar complaint filed in MUR 7447.

In order to provide the Commission with the most comprehensive response to the complaints, we will need additional time to incorporate relevant information from these recent developments. In addition, we would like to respond to both complaints on the same day to ensure consistency and completeness. Therefore, I respectfully request an additional 30-day extension from the current due date in MUR 7447 – until October 28 – to respond to both complaints.
