**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission granting an extension of 45 days to respond to the Commission's reason to believe findings in this matter, Respondent Hillary for America hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MURs 7291 and 7449 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of 45 days.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for a period of 45 calendar days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in these matters.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
