CERTIFICATION

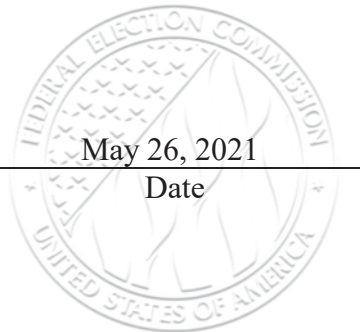
I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary for the Federal Election Commission executive session on May 20, 2021, do hereby certify that the Commission decided by a vote of 4-2 to take the following actions in MUR 7454:

1. Find reason to believe that Blue Magnolia Investments, LLC violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(g)(5).
2. Find reason to believe the allegation that Highway 76 LLC violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(g)(5).
3. Find reason to believe that DefendArizona and Benjamin Ottenhoff in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(g)(2) and (4).
4. Dismiss the allegation that Blue Magnolia Investments, LLC violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122.
5. Dismiss the allegation that Highway 76 LLC violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122.
6. Dismiss the allegation that Blue Magnolia Investments, LLC violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104.
7. Dismiss the allegation that Highway 76 LLC violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104.
8. Enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with Respondents
9. Send the appropriate letters.
