26 On July 31, 2018, the Commission found reason to believe that the American Federation
27 of Teachers, AFL-CIO Committee on Political Education and Lorretta Johnson in her official
28 capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(2) and (4), by failing to
29 timely disclose the Committee's receipts and disbursements. The Commission authorized pre-
30 probable cause conciliation with Respondents. Attached is a negotiated conciliation agreement.
31 Attachment 1. We recommend that the Commission accept this agreement and close the file in
