On August 9, 2018, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging that you had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On June 20, 2019, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to dismiss the allegation that you violated 52 U.S.C § 30116(a)(1)(A). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
