As consideration for the Federal Election Commission's ("Commission") agreement to extend the time to respond to the notification of the Complaint sent by the Office of General Counsel on September 27, 2022, Respondent American Electric Power hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7464 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of thirty (30) days. American Electric Power will have until November 18, 2022, to submit its response to the notification sent by the Office of General Counsel on September 27, 2022. Any additional modification to the deadline and this agreement may be made by the mutual consent of the parties.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil enforcement action for a period of thirty (30) days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
