Dear Mr. Tyrrell:

On June 10, 2021, your client, Honor and Principles PAC and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer, was notified that the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") found reason to believe that it violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On April 6, 2023, the Commission found that there is no probable cause to believe that Honor and Principles PAC and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122. Accordingly, on June 1, 2023 the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
