On June 5, 2020, your client, James Ryan, was notified that the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") received a complaint alleging that he may have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). On May 20, 2021, the Commission voted to take no action regarding as to your client and, subsequently, on June 1, 2023, the Commission closed the filed in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision is not required in this matter in connection with your client, but if one is issued, it will be provided to you.
