Dear Mr. Tyrrell:

On June 10, 2021, your clients, LZP, LLC, and Independence and Freedom Network, were notified that the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") found reason to believe that they violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On April 6, 2023, the Commission considered the General Counsel's and the respondents' briefs, but there were an insufficient number of votes to find probable cause to believe that your clients violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122. Accordingly, on June 1, 2023 the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
