I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on April 06, 2023, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

Find probable cause to believe that Independence and Freedom Network, Inc., violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 by making contributions in the name of another and LZP, LLC violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 by knowingly allowing its name to be used in the making of contributions in the name of another, as recommended in the Memorandum to the Commission dated April 3, 2023.

Commissioners Broussard, Lindenbaum, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.

2. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

Dismiss the allegations against Independence and Freedom Network, Inc. and LZP, LLC in an exercise of prosecutorial discretion.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners Broussard, Lindenbaum, and Weintraub dissented.
