I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on April 06, 2023, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 1-5 to:

Find probable cause to believe that Honor and Principles PAC and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 by knowingly accepting contributions made in the name of another, as recommended in the Memorandum to the Commission dated April 3, 2023.

Commissioner Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners Broussard, Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, and Trainor dissented.

2. Decided by a vote of 4-2 to:

Find no probable cause to believe that Honor and Principles PAC and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 by knowingly accepting contributions made in the name of another.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the decision. Commissioners Broussard and Weintraub dissented.
