On July 31, 2019, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that Freedom Vote, Inc., violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, 30104(a), (b), (g)(2), and 30120 (a), (d), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of the notification letter is included here for your convenience.

Pursuant to its investigation of this matter, the Commission has issued the attached subpoena requiring Freedom Vote, Inc., and you as its Executive Director to provide information which will assist the Commission in carrying out its statutory duty of supervising compliance with the Act. It is required that you submit all answers to questions under oath within 30 days of your receipt of this subpoena.
