I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on June 23, 2020, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 2-2 to:
 - a. Find reason to believe that 45Committee, Inc. violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, and 30104 by not registering as a political committee and meeting the Act's organizational, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements.
 - b. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated August 21, 2019.
 - c. Authorize the use of compulsory process.
 - d. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Walther and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Hunter and Trainor dissented.

2. Failed by a vote of 2-1 to:
 - a. Close the file.
 - b. Send the appropriate letters

3. Failed by a vote of 2-2 to:

Authorize the Office of General Counsel to defend the Commission in *Campaign Legal Center v. FEC*, No. 20-809.

4. Failed by a vote of 0-2 to:

Dismiss the complaint.

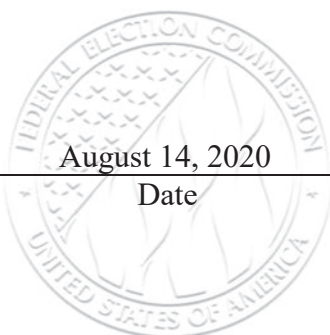
Commissioners Walther and Weintraub dissented. Commissioners Hunter and Trainor abstained.
