On February 15, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Mike Johnson for Louisiana and William Vanderbrook in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging the Committee had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On June 22, 2022, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to dismiss the allegations. On September 21, 2022, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
