On May 29, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Common Defense Action Fund (fka Common Defense/Beyond the Choir Action Fund) and Perry O'Brien in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On December 15, 2022, the Commission voted to dismiss this matter. A statement of reasons providing the basis for the Commission's decision will follow.
