Dear Ms. Dougher:

The Federal Election Commission has considered the allegations contained in your complaint dated September 17, 2018, but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe the Democratic Executive Committee of Florida and Fran Garcia, in her official capacity as treasurer, and Bill Nelson for U.S. Senate and Peggy Gagnon, in her official capacity as treasurer, violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, on June 1, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.

The Federal Election Campaign Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. *See* 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8). If you have any questions, please contact Don Campbell, the attorney assigned to this matter, at (202) 694-1650.
