Dear Mr. Reiff:

On September 20, 2018, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Democratic Executive Committee of Florida and Francesca Menes, in her official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging that your clients had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On May 20, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe the Democratic Executive Committee of Florida and Fran Garcia, in her official capacity as treasurer, violated the Act. Accordingly, the Commission voted to close its file in this matter on June 1, 2021.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
