Dear Mr. Spies:

On October 12, 2018, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, 1st Street Foundation, Inc. and Matthew Eby, of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations in the complaint and information supplied by respondents, the Commission, on November 9, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegations that 1st Street Foundation, Inc. violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a) by making a prohibited in-kind contribution and Matthew Eby, as Executive Director of 1st Street Foundation, Inc., violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a) by consenting to the making of a prohibited contribution. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
