Dear Mr. Green:

On October 19, 2018, and November 8, 2018, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a Complaint and an Amended Complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Copies of the Complaint and Amended Complaint were forwarded to you at the time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the Complaint and Amended Complaint, and information supplied by you, the Commission, on July 13, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegation that Save Coos Jobs Committee violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.20(g) by knowingly accepting or receiving prohibited foreign national donations and to close its file in the matter. The Factual and Legal Analysis and/or Statement(s) of Reasons, which more fully explain the Commission's decision, will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
