I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on April 06, 2021, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
 - a. Find reason to believe that Heritage Action for America violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c)(1) by failing to disclose donors who contributed for political purposes.
 - b. Find reason to believe that Heritage Action for America violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c)(2)(C) by failing to further identify the donors who donated for the purpose of funding an independent expenditure.
 - c. Authorize the use of compulsory process.
 - d. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 19, 2021.
 - e. Approve the appropriate letters.

 - a. Dismiss the matter under *Heckler v. Chaney*.
