CERTIFICATION

I, Laura E. Sinram, Acting Secretary and Clerk of the Federal Election Commission, do hereby certify that on June 10, 2021, the Commission decided by a vote of 6-0 to take the following actions in MUR 7519:

1. Find no reason to believe that Arizona Democratic Party and Rick McGuire, in his official capacity as treasurer, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(b)(1) or 11 C.F.R. § 300.32(a)(2) by using non-federal funds to promote or support a federal candidate.
2. Find no reason to believe that Elect Katie Hobbs for Secretary of State and Martin Quezada, in his official capacity as treasurer, and Katie Hobbs violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(f)(1) or 11 C.F.R. § 300.71 by using non-federal funds to promote or support a federal candidate.
3. Find no reason to believe that Arizona Democratic Party and Rick McGuire, in his official capacity as treasurer, violated 11 C.F.R. § 106.7 by failing to allocate the costs of the advertisement between federal and non-federal accounts.
4. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated October 9, 2019, subject to the edits circulated by Commissioner Trainor's Office on behalf of the Republican Commissioners on May 13, 2021 at 9:16 a.m. and the additional edits circulated on behalf of the Democratic Commissioners on June 3, 2021 at 5:31 p.m.
