On October 29, 2018, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Families & Teachers for Antonio Villaraigosa for Governor 2018 (“Families & Teachers”), of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your client at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by your client, the Commission, on November 9, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegation that Families & Teachers violated 52 U.S.C. § 30116(a)(1)(A) and closed the file in this matter. One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission’s decision may follow.
