Dear Ms. Damaskos:

The Federal Election Commission has considered the allegations contained in your complaints dated July 16, 2018, September 17, 2018, October 22, 2018, and December 7, 2018, respectively, but there was an insufficient number of votes for the Commission to determine whether or not there was reason to believe that Respondents violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). Accordingly, on August 29, 2022, the Commission closed the files in these matters.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.


