Cause Conciliation Agreement

I. INTRODUCTION

On October 18, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that News for Democracy ("NFD") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(c)(1) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"), by failing to report independent expenditures and 52 U.S.C. § 30120(a) by failing to include a required disclaimer on ads containing express advocacy. On November 14, 2022, the Commission approved a conciliation agreement

Certification ("Cert.") \P 3.a, b (Oct. 19, 2022). The Commission also directed the Office of General Counsel to draft a conciliation agreement consistent with the revised Factual & Legal Analysis. *Id.* \P 4.b.

We believe this negotiated agreement sufficiently vindicates the Commission's enforcement interests and is a reasonable resolution of this matter given NFD's defunct status. Therefore, we recommend that the Commission accept the attached negotiated conciliation agreement and close the file.

- 1. Accept the Conciliation Agreement with News for Democracy;
- 2. Approve the appropriate letters; and
- 3. Close the file.
