On October 31, 2018, the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") notified your client, Calista Corporation, of a complaint alleging that it had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your client at that time.

On September 28, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe or dismiss the allegations. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
