Dear Mr. Keane:

On October 31, 2018, the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") notified your clients, Yukon Kusko Political Action Committee Inc., and Margaret Pohjola, in her official capacity as treasurer, and Jennine Jordan, of a complaint alleging that they had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

On September 28, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided over whether to find reason to believe or dismiss the allegations. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
