

Dear Ms. Nesburg:

The Federal Election Commission has considered the allegations contained in your complaint received on October 30, 2018, but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that NRCC and Keith Davis in his official capacity as treasurer, Troy Balderson and Balderson for Congress and J. Matthew Yuskevich in his official capacity as treasurer violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, on September 28, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
