On November 7, 2018, the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) notified your clients, Leah Vukmir and Leah for Senate and Thomas Datwyler in his official capacity as Treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was previously forwarded to you.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by the respondents, the Commission voted to dismiss the allegations and close the file in this matter on November 9, 2021. A Factual and Legal Analysis or Statement(s) of Reasons, which more fully explain the Commission’s decision, will follow.
