RE: Complaint Regarding Lack of Disclaimer; US Senate 2018 General Election in the State of Indiana

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is in the form of a COMPLAINT to the Federal Election Commission regarding a political mailing that is absent a disclaimer as required. (11 CFR 110.11)

The undersigned states that the following are true and accurate:

- 1. The undersigned is submitting this on his own behalf as an Indiana voter.
- 2. The undersigned resides at

, Fort Wayne IN 46814

- 3. The mailing was received at the address shown on October 29, 2018. An accurate photocopy of the printed mailing is attached and made a part of this complaint.
- The mailing shows a postal indicia of "Standard U.S. Postage PAID Milwaukee, WI Permit No. 1885"
- 5. There is no disclaimer printed on the face or reverse of the printed cardstock.
- The undersigned as a matter of fact can not determine who paid for the mailing, who
 authorized the mailing or whether it came from a candidate committee, party committee or an
 entity representing an independent expenditure.
- The printed piece contains negative allegations and disparaging statements against the candidacy of Mike Braun, the Republican nominee for US Senator in the 2018 General Election in Indiana.
- 8. The printed piece contains what can be perceived as positive comments regarding Lucy Brenton, the Libertarian nominee for US Senator in the 2018 General Election in Indiana.
- 9. The undersigned does not believe that the Libertarian Party nor Ms. Brenton is responsible for the financing or authorization of this mailing.
- 10. The undersigned infers that mailing is intended by the person or entity responsible for the mailing to be favorable to the candidacy of Joe Donnelly, the Democratic nominee for US Senator in the 2018 General Election in Indiana.

It is believed that an investigation of the complaint would reveal what person or entity was responsible for the mailing by contacting the holder of the USPS indicia.

The Complainant asks that the Federal Election Commission investigate the complaint, determine the responsible party, determine whether a violation of federal election law has occurred and assess whatever penalty or remedy that the Commission deems appropriate.




